

# Housing services in the community

Following the successful transfer of council owned homes back in-house, we have seen a number of positive changes, in line with our pledge to 'listen and act' on tenant feedback, as well as big financial savings.

Our employment team has been busy supporting people of all ages and abilities into work, training, education or volunteering. Throughout 2025 they:



Delivered **301 workshops** or training sessions across Cheltenham



Supported **57 people** into work



Received **97% satisfaction**, with 100% of people reporting an increase in confidence

The wellbeing of our residents remains a top priority. Last summer, we worked closely with local partners and helped 91 families in need with free essential school items. We are looking at other opportunities to help those who are struggling financially during 2026.

## Elections

## Voter ID

If you want to vote in person, including anyone acting as a proxy on your behalf, you'll need to bring an accepted form of photo identification (ID) to the polling station.

Voters who do not produce valid photo ID or a Voter Authority Certificate, will not be allowed to vote on the day. The photo ID must be an original and cannot be a photocopy. A free Voter Authority Certificate is available if you do not have photo ID.
